

Conditions of Enrolment:

1. It is the responsibility of the participant to arrive on time. The participant must inform Tantrum in advance if they are unable to attend;
2. Non-enrolled students are not the responsibility of Tantrum;
3. Fees must be paid by the beginning of the term prior to commencing workshops;
4. Any student attending more than one workshop in any year will be required to become a member of Tantrum Theatre Co-operative
5. A term consists of 9 weeks with one workshop per week;
6. Refunds / credits will not be given for student absences or withdrawals from workshops, nor will make up workshops be provided in such circumstances;
7. Refunds will only be made where workshops are discontinued due to insufficient enrolments;
8. A student is not permitted to re-enrol for a new term or attend a workshop if they are in arrears for fees in a previous term or a previous workshop;
9. Tantrum reserves the right to decline or cancel an enrolment in any of its workshops; to cancel workshops at any time; to cancel workshops due to insufficient enrolment numbers; to change the tutor for any workshop at any time.

In addition please note that a breakdown of both Participant's and Tantrum's Rights and Responsibilities is included in the Tantrum Theatre Co-operative membership form and agreement of these is also a condition of enrolment.
